2 Samuel 6:1-23 (NIV)

1 David again brought together out of Israel chosen men, thirty thousand in all. 2 He and all his men set out from Baalah of Judah to bring up from there the ark of God, which is called by the Name, the name of the LORD Almighty, who is enthroned between the cherubim that are on the ark. 3 They set the ark of God on a new cart and brought it from the house of Abinadab, which was on the hill. Uzzah and

Ahio, sons of Abinadab, were guiding the new cart 4 with the ark of God on it, and Ahio was walking in front of it. 5 David and the whole house of Israel were celebrating with all their might before the LORD, with songs, and with harps, lyres, tambourines, sistrums and cymbals. 6 When they came to the threshing floor of Nakon, Uzzah reached out and took hold of the ark of God, because the oxen stumbled. 7 The LORD's anger burned against

Uzzah because of his irreverent act; therefore God struck him down, and he died there beside the ark of God. 8 Then David was angry because the LORD's wrath had broken out against Uzzah, and to this day that place is called Perez Uzzah. 9 David was afraid of the LORD that day and said, "How can the ark of the LORD ever come to me?" 10 He was not willing to take the ark of the LORD to be with him in the City of David. Instead, he took it

aside to the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite. 11 The ark of the LORD remained in the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite for three months, and the LORD blessed him and his entire household. 12 Now King David was told, "The LORD has blessed the household of Obed-Edom and everything he has, because of the ark of God." So David went down and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obed-Edom to the City of David with rejoicing.

13 When those who were carrying the ark of the LORD had taken six steps, he sacrificed a bull and a fattened calf. 14 David, wearing a linen ephod, danced before the LORD with all his might, 15 while he and the entire house of Israel brought up the ark of the LORD with shouts and the sound of trumpets. 16 As the ark of the LORD was entering the City of David, Michal daughter of Saul watched from a window. And when she saw King David leaping

and dancing before the LORD, she despised him in her heart. 17 They brought the ark of the LORD and set it in its place inside the tent that David had pitched for it, and David sacrificed burnt offerings and fellowship offerings before the LORD. 18 After he had finished sacrificing the burnt offerings and fellowship offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD Almighty. 19 Then he gave a loaf of bread, a cake of dates and a

cake of raisins to each person in the whole crowd of Israelites, both men and women. And all the people went to their homes. 20 When David returned home to bless his household, Michal daughter of Saul came out to meet him and said, "How the king of Israel has distinguished himself today, disrobing in the sight of the slave girls of his servants as any vulgar fellow would!" 21 David said to Michal, "It was before the LORD, who chose me rather

Through the ***prompting of the holy spirit***, I feel ***very strongly*** that it is ***time to enter*** into a "***new dimension***" of our ***understanding***, as a ***Church***, and as ***individuals***, of what "***Real Worship Is!***"

We're ***living in a world today*** where people have ***all kinds of superstitious ideas*** about "***How God Works!***"

The ***living church today***, in a very ***real sense***, is ***where*** the Ark Of The Covenant, or ***THE GLORY OF THE LORD***, is to ***abide***.

2 Samuel 6:1-5 (NIV)

2 Samuel 6:7 (NIV)
 The LORD's anger burned
 against Uzzah because of his
 irreverent act; therefore God
 struck him down, and he died
 there beside the ark of God.

2 Samuel 6:8-9 (NIV)
 8 Then David was angry because the
 LORD's wrath had broken out against
 Uzzah, and to this day that place is called
 Perez Uzzah. 9 David was afraid of the
 LORD that day and said, "How can the
 ark of the LORD ever come to me?"

2 Samuel 6:810-23 (NIV)
 10 He was not willing to take the ark of the LORD to be with him in the City of David. Instead, he took it aside to the house of Obed-Edom the Gittite. 11 The ark of the LORD remained in the house of Obed-Edom

the Gittite for three months, and the LORD blessed him and his entire household. 12 Now King David was told, "The LORD has blessed the household of Obed-Edom and everything he has, because of the ark of God." So David went down and

"How can the Ark of The Lord ever come to me?"

"How" the Glory Of God "moves" among people, and "how" it "doesn't".

29

The ***contrast*** between "***human means***" and "***divine means***", of seeing The ***Glory*** of God move.

The **difference** in
 “***means***” or “***ways***” of
 introducing ***The Glory***
 of God **among** people:

31

Adopt the traditional
 “***methods***” of the
world.

32

The “***way***” The LORD
 does things is **totally**
removed from the
 world’s “***way***”.

33

Worship is a “**walk in**
praise” before God, and
 “**dependence upon**
him” in everything you do;
24 hours per day!

***“A cart is made
 out of boards
 and big wheels!”
 (that’s a preacher joke)***

2 Samuel 6:13,
 “When those who were
 carrying the ark of The Lord
 had taken **six steps** he
sacrificed a bull and a
fattened calf.”

Hebrews 13:15,
 "Through Jesus, therefore, let us **continually** offer to God a **sacrifice of praise** — the **fruit of lips** that **openly profess** His Name!"

37

Hebrews 13:16,
 "And ***do not forget*** to ***do good*** and to ***share with others***, for with such ***sacrifices*** God is ***pleased.***"

38

Romans 12:1,
 "Present your ***body***, a ***living sacrifice*** in ***worship*** to God."

"***Worship***" leads the way for ***The Glory of God's weight***, and of ***his purpose*** working in the ***midst*** of His people.

"That ***happens*** when music is ***worship*** rather than ***performance!***"

"***Divine***" means (ways) ***contrasted*** with "***human***" means (ways)!"

**Everybody's
"Needs Are Met"
Where The Glory of
the Lord is!**

2 Samuel 6:20,
"How the **King Of Israel** has
distinguished himself, today,
disrobing in the **sight** of the
slave girls, of his servants, as any
vulgar fellow would!"

Saul depended on the
energy of flesh;
David depended on the
Spirit Of God!

Samuel 6:22,
"I will **become** even **more**
undignified than this, and I
will be **humiliated** in my
own eyes!"

The **Glory** of The Lord
attends people who **glorify**
him, and are **not concerned**
with **peer pressure**, or **ego**,
or **what other people** might
think!

Don't be "**self**
conscious", be "**God**
conscious"!
