"He Knows Everything!"

1

Psalm 139:1-6 (NIV)

1 O Lord, you have searched me and you know me. 2 You know when I sit and when I rise; you perceive my thoughts from afar. 3 You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways.

4 Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O Lord. 5 You hem me in -- behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me. 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.

Life's ***major pursuit*** should ***not*** be to "***know yourself***", but ***rather*** to "***KNOW GOD!***"

When we "***read the bible***", we begin to get this ***amazingly clear picture*** of "***who God really is!***"

"Omni - ", according to Webster's Dictionary, means "***all***".

The Bible teaches that
"God is omniscient"; that
 He has **complete, total**
knowledge!

God knows
absolutely
everything!!!
 (Say that with me.)

God not **only** knows
 about things, he
 knows **how**
everything works!

Psalm 147:5,
"Great is our Lord, and
mighty in power! His
understanding has no
limit!"

From **God's view**, He is
able to see the **"future"**,
 the **"past"**, and the
"present", **all** at the
same time!

Romans 11:33-35 (MSG)
"Have you ever come on
anything quite like this
extravagant generosity of God;
this deep, deep wisdom. It's way
over our heads. We'll never
figure it out.

Is there anyone around who can explain God? Anyone smart enough to tell Him what to do? Anyone who has done Him such a huge favor that God has to ask his advice?"
