Psalm 66:1-7 (NIV)

1 Shout for joy to God, all the earth! 2 Sing the glory of his name; make his praise glorious. 3 Say to God, "How awesome are your deeds! So great is your power that your enemies cringe before you. 4 All the earth bows down to you; they sing praise to you, they sing praise to your name."

5 Come and see what God has done, how awesome his works in man's behalf! 6 He turned the sea into dry land, they passed through the waters on foot— come, let us rejoice in him. 7 He rules forever by his power, his eyes watch the nations— let not the rebellious rise up against him.

There is *no equal*  
to our God!

What can he do;  
just how *powerful* is

*"Omnipotence"* means *all powerful!* His *unrestrained, indescribable, infinite power* and *abilities* have *no parameters!*

Romans 1:20,  
 "For since the creation of the world,  
 God's invisible qualities, His **eternal  
 power** and **divine nature** have been  
**clearly seen**, being understood  
 from what has been **made**, so that  
 men are **without excuse**."

There simply **cannot be a  
 design** without a **designer!**

 many **parts**, all working **together**,  
 could have been **formed** by the  
**natural selection random  
 process**, seems, I **freely** confess,
